- Ad-hoc extra sessions are charged at £10 per hour. Prior approval should be taken in writing before bringing your child for extra sessions.
- Fees to be paid "Termly" in advance. Please contact the accounts team if you wish to pay on monthly basis. Fee needs to be paid by the due date mentioned on fees advice. Overdue fees would incur additional £10 per day.
- 1 full term notice for withdrawal must be given in writing, otherwise parents will be liable to pay an additional term's fee in lieu of notice.
